Taxes

In 2016, the Association paid a total of \$16,164.84 in real estate taxes. There are a total of 1088 lots that share the cost of these taxes by payment of their Association dues. Each lot's share is \$14.86.

If your 2016 assessment is paid in full, and you itemize deductions on your income tax, you can claim that amount on line 6 of Schedule A.

Member Cards

New this year, we are sending out Member Cards to all Dutch Hollow Lake Members upon payment of dues. Two Member Cards will be issued per Member. (If you have multiple lots you will only receive two cards.) They will have your name on the card and your lot #. Member Cards will be used to identify members when using the amenities at Dutch Hollow Lake. This also allows Management to easily identify non-members utilizing Dutch Hollow amenities.

How the Member Cards will be used: As a member, (when you are present with your family/guests) you will be required to show the following when using amenities:

Pool – Member Card and Season Pool Pass (show lifeguard)

Tennis – Member Card and Tennis Pass (show receptionist or post on clip board on Tennis Court.)

Beach –Member Card (Manager will make rounds and ask for identification.)

Members (when you are not present with your guests) having guests are required to notify the Association Office in advance. In order for a guest to use the amenities, guests will be required to stop by office and receive a daily guest pass. Members must call in guests to office or they will not be issued a daily guest pass, the guest will have to pay the non-member daily fee.

DHL Snowmobiling

The equestrian/walking trails on the greenway around Dutch Hollow are open for use by snowmobiles under proper weather conditions. Snowmobilers must not trespass on private properties. They may be operated on the Lake. The DHL trail is connected to a more extensive trail system maintained by local area snowmobile clubs. The trails at DHL are CLOSED for snowmobiling when County/local trails are closed due to weather conditions.

Town of LaValle and Town of Woodland are hosting a public meeting to discuss new laws on shoreline ordinances, manure management, and the permitting process.

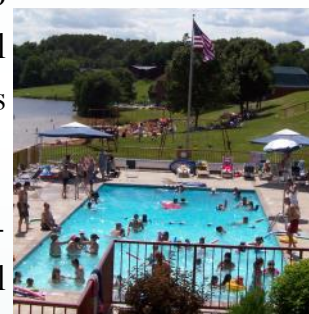
