Taxes

In 2016, the Association paid a total of \$16,164.84 in real estate taxes. There are a total of 1088 lots that share the cost of these taxes by payment of their Association dues. **Each lot's share is \$14.86.**

If your 2016 assessment is paid in full, and you itemize deductions on your income tax, you can claim that amount on line 6 of Schedule A.
