Playing it Safe

It is the season for deer to be on the move. Your Safety and Security Committee would like to give you some ideas on preventing deer and car collisions.

DON'T SWERVE most accidents, injuries, and deaths from deer-related accidents are caused when vehicles swerve in attempting to avoid a deer. The safest thing to do if possible is to slow down and let the deer hit your vehicle.

DEER CROSSING SIGNS pay attention to these signs as they are placed in areas known to have deer crossing. But realize deer can be anywhere so keep a constant eye out for them.

KNOW HOW DEER TRAVEL they usually travel in groups, if you see one, others may be close. This time of the year they are on the move throughout the day and night.

USE HIGH BEAMS try to give yourself the best opportunity to see the deer but be courteous to other drivers when they are approaching you.

KNOW YOUR ROADS some roads have brush cleared back a good distance; this gives you more ability to see the deer.

Dam Maintenance

The DHLPOA is the owner of the Dam.

Dam owners are required to maintain the dam as directed by regular inspections by the DNR, and engineering professionals.

One of the maintenance requirements is keeping the dam mowed regularly. This is one of the duties taken care of by our maintenance staff. (Mowing helps prevent overgrowth that may damage the dam, keep rodents away, and makes visual inspections simple.)
